I wanted to acknowledge your comments at the Board of Supervisors study session on the state of the CalPERS pension system on May 4. As this topic continues to be of concern to the employees and retirees of Sutter County, the Board of Supervisors, and the residents of Sutter County, it will be important that the perspectives of all parties are considered.

Although you were the only county employee to speak at the study session, I appreciated hearing what you had to say. I share your view that Sutter County employees work very hard on behalf of the residents of the County. And I understand why you would be concerned by suggestions of trimming benefits the employees work hard to earn.

I also understand that speaking in public is difficult for some people. I have had much practice and still feel uncomfortable sometimes. But as the Board considers strategies to deal with very real concerns for the long term costs of the CalPERS pension, I think it will continue to be important for employees to be part of the process by sharing their views with Board members at the public meetings.

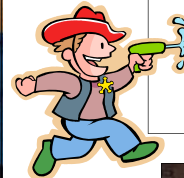
SCEA Membership Appreciation
