By affiliating with AFSCME, Local 1 has –

- The City of Live Oak joined Local 1 early last year and recently ratified their very first contract.
- For the first time in history, Community College District members received a larger raise than faculty.
- The board added video conferencing technology that allows us to start meetings earlier and reduce travel related costs allowing for greater participation from our areas in El Dorado, Merced, Sutter, and Yuba counties, not just the greater Bay Area. We hope to expand its use to allow greater member participation in the near future.
- Contra Costa County ratified a 3 year deal with a 10% wage increase and no increase in health care costs.
- El Dorado County Employees Association has the highest membership they've ever had.
- Yuba County Employees Association ratified a 6.5% COLA.
- Central Contra Costa Sanitation District member's ratified an across the board wage increase of 3.75% effective immediately plus three years of 2 - 3.75%, no health care cost sharing, and preserved sick time cash out.
- West County Wastewater Managerial Employees bargained for a COLA of 10% over the next 3 years.
- City of Pleasant Hill unanimously voted YES to a three year contract! They ratified a 9% wage increase over the next 3 years, established a retiree health savings accounts, plus much more.
- Contra Costa County Housing Authority ratified a COLA of 6% over the next 3 years, a \$1,000 signing bonus, market equity adjustments for seven classifications ranging from 0.48% to 3.49%, and money back on medical.
- City of Berkeley ratified a 5% COLA over the next 2 years, continuation of fully paid medical by the employer, and a cash-in-lieu increase to \$576.00 per month.
- Georgetown Divide Public Utility District and the Cameron Park Community Services District passed contracts, with wage increases, where members voted unanimously.
- Local 1 endorsed candidates' won seats on the West County Wastewater Board of Directors and Yuba City, City Council during the midterm elections.
